





TOP 15 RECENT UPDATES IN LOCAL SEARCH - FEB, 2016

- 1. Google has launched a <u>pilot program</u> that feeds information into the local knowledge panel via the Schema encoding on the brand website for *multi-location businesses*. Google is recommending <u>JSON-LD</u> to code schema on the website & marking up everything.
- 2. This month, Bing was spotted testing an expanded carousel on its search results. A search result for a local search on dentists was showing a carousel of medical providers & a click on them redirected us to a page of results about that person. Also, it was good to see that the local pack shrank when the carousel appeared, thus making it easier for the users to browse. But as of now, it is limited to medical providers as search for other professionals like attorneys & engineers were showing normal results. So maybe Bing will roll out the full version of this new feature in the near future.


- 3. Facebook was planning on offering free basic internet services in India. As you can probably guess, this decision was solely driven by self-interest. Both Google and Facebook were trying to capture the market of over 1 billion people. But as of now, it has been <u>put on hold</u> as the free internet program of Facebook is against net neutrality.

- 5. Local search predictions from around a dozen people were uploaded on Yext's blog. Some of them are really interesting. Check it out.

Product Rich Snippet with Reviews

It is very likely that you already know what Google Knowledge Graph looks like. But in case you don't, just search for any alpha company & you will see every single detail about the company listed on the right side of the search result.

All the features that make a search listing look "Good", such as Rich Snippets & Knowledge Graph can be scored by adding the Schema formatted Structured Data of your website content.

Schema markup allows you to

- Bring forth search results Rich Snippets, Breadcrumbs, live blogs & search boxes.
- Drive data into Google's Knowledge Graph, Maps & even results.
- Make your content easier to understated for the search engine.

Structured Data Markup allows search engines to interpret content more efficiently & generate Rich Snippets.

Since the very beginning, programmers have been trying to understand human language using computers; but it is way too hard. For instance, we use so many different formats for date & time that it can be difficult to interpret.

- February 1st, 2016
- 1st February, 2016
- Feb 1, 2016
- 02-1-2016
- 1/2/16

Confusing, isn't it? Search engines also face the same problem.

Despite the fact that search engineers have done a tremendous job in this regard, they still need help & structured data does exactly that.

History

Google started to use Structured Data Markup in 2009. They continually developed their support to multiple formats as technology advanced. In 2011, all the major search engines, including Bing, Google & Yahoo agreed to support one standard vocabulary named Schema, which consists of different standard options such as Microdata, RDFa & JSON-LD.

→ You may want to bookmark the website "Schema.org", as it has all the supported Structured Data codes.

Coming back to the date & time instance, Schema requires them to be in a single format, specifically ISO 8601. (2016-02-10T22:00:00.)

In daily use of Structured Data Markup, the Schema Markup that uses ISO 8601 time/date format for machines will look like this <meta_itemprop="startDate" content="2016-02-10T22:00"> & for humans it will be **Wednesday Night, February 10**th.

Understanding the Terminology

To fully learn Structured Data you must understand the terminology used:

❖ The additional information like reviews, prices, events, images, etc. that are included in search listing are called Rich Snippets.

Microdata & RDFa are the structured code formats which make it easy for search engines to understand visible data. They are mostly used to markup visible content such as phone numbers & addresses. The example below has Microdata Tags marked in yellow.

❖ JSON-LD is based on JavaScript Markup & it remains hidden from the eyes of a visitor. This allows you to add content without troubling your on page layout text. Nevertheless, JSON-LD is NOT a short-cut for hiding marked up text. Google specifically says that markup should be same as what's on the page. For example:

Tip:- If you are just getting started marking up you content, use Schema supported formats such as Microdata & JSON-LD because the search engines embrace it & Microdata is a part of HTML 5 standard.



Using hCard Markup you can generate Rich Snippets like LinkedIn. But be aware that hCard Markup is not Schemma.org/person. They are very much similar, but it is not supported by Google. Use the Microformats.org hCard Creator to generate such codes.

Local Business






If you own a brick & mortar business then Schema <u>Schema.org/LocalBusiness</u> is very useful for you. Not necessarily for Rich Snippets, but for feeding data directly into the Knowledge Graph.

However, Google is testing this markup on few sites & hopefully they will roll it out to all sites in the future. This way they will get data directly from the website instead of a third party. It will also allow website owners to manage their Name, address, phone numbers, opening hours & menus with ease.

<u>Schema.org/VideoObject</u> is not of much use because Google will only generate Video thumbnail Rich Snippet for video focused websites such as Youtube & Vimeo. But yes, this will change in the near future.



A "breadcrumb" is a type of secondary navigation scheme that reveals a user's location in a website. Google might automatically generate these, but in case they don't, you can use <u>Schema.org/BreadcrumbList.</u>

Is Structured Data Markup useful for your website?

With every passing day, more & more small websites are getting Rich Snippets displayed in search results. So if your website features any of the following, you should start utilizing them right away:

- If your business involves dealing with local customers then you can utilize <u>Schema.org/LocalBusiness</u>
- Content with Reviews & Ratings
- Recipes
- Business Directories
- Any website that has more than one level can employ Breadcrumbs.
- Selling individual products.
- Event Information or Calendars.
- Social Networking or Communities.

Prerequisites to get your Rich Snippets displayed.


In order to get your Rich Snippets displayed on search result listings, your code has to first pass the <u>Structured Data Tester</u>. If you have any doubts regarding your code passing the test, review their guidelines & ensure that following is applied:



- Frror free website
- Product Data is not always supported without reviews.
- No Hidden Markup Data
- The marked up Structured Data must represent the main content of the page.
- Don't name your CSS classes the same as Microdata markup tags.
- Make sure your marked up code passes Google's <u>Structured Data Testing Tool</u>.

Structured Data Markup Helper

Google's <u>Structured Data Markup Helper Tool</u> makes it easy to markup up your HTML code. This tool generates sample Microdata Markup & allows you to tag elements of your page.



Use GoodRelations Vocabulary for enhanced Markup

By integrating <u>GoodRelations e-commerce schemas</u>, Schema.org enhances the level of information you can add for companies, products, stores, etc. The insane level of detail that GoodRelations offers is astonishing. From product weight, to its condition (new or used), payment types & almost about everything.

The issue is that both Google & Bing are not using this additional level of data markup. Although, GoodRelations RDFa will be supported by Google, GoodRelations Schema tags do not offer the advantage of a Rich Snippet result in search like the Microdata.

FRESH WEBMASTER GUIDELINES ISSUED BY GOOGLE



Google recently released fresh <u>guidelines</u> for webmasters. At first we thought that they just revamped the format, but after reading further we realized that they have added some brand new guidelines, which we have outlined below.

Design your site for all device types and sizes, including desktops, tablets, and smartphones. Use the mobile friendly testing tool to test how well your pages work on mobile devices, and get feedback on what needs to be fixed.

For the first time they have mentioned in their guidelines that a responsive design is crucial. So if you haven't opted for responsive design yet, do it now; or you will be left far, far behind.

Make your site's important content visible by default. Google is able to crawl HTML content hidden inside navigational elements such as tabs or expanding sections, however we consider this content less accessible to users, and believe that you should make your most important information visible in the default page view.

Seems legit that your most important information should be on the default page view. However, it has also made it clear that up to which extent Googlebot is able to index & crawl.



If possible, secure your site's connections with HTTPS. Encrypting interactions between the user and your website is a good practice for communication on the web.

Shifting to a secure website is a no brainier. Google has already made it clear that they want to see all websites within their search results as HTTPS. They took their HTTPS obsession one step further & started rewarding the HTTPS websites, while shaming the ones who haven't opted for HTTPS yet.


Ensure that your pages are useful for readers with visual impairments, for example, by testing usability with a screen-reader.

A great reminder to the webmasters! Google never shed light on the importance of generating content for users with disabilities. But as you can see, it could become a trend in the upcoming years.

This time, Google cleaned up & clarified some of the existing guidelines, so that they can be understood easily. 






What is this Peach App?

The future will reveal how Peach can be helpful to Brands and small businesses alike.


